On **Tuesday 19th May 2026**, Year 4 are going to the We are Curious Museum on a Science class trip.

We The Curious is a playful, immersive museum where visitors can explore science, art, and big ideas through more than 200 interactive exhibits. Located in Millennium Square on Bristol's historic Harbourside, it encourages experimentation—whether that's stepping inside a giant bubble, creating animations, exploring how the body works, or travelling through space in its unique 3D planetarium. The centre focuses on making science accessible and fun, blending creativity with hands-on learning to inspire curiosity and imagination. This all links with our science topics of electricity, sound and states of matter.

Key information:

When: Tuesday 19th May 2026

What time: Leave school on coach at 9:00am, arrive back at school 3:00pm

What does my child need Small bag with packed lunch and water bottle

Transport: Children will be travelling by coach from school to We are Curious, the coach will leave school at 9:00am and leave Bristol at 2:00pm.

How much will it cost? In fulfilling the school's charging policy it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £20 per pupil to ensure this event takes place. The cost is due to coach cost, entrance and workshops. Your child would not be denied a place on the trip if you decline to make a voluntary payment, but the school will not proceed with this event unless it is clear that there will be sufficient voluntary contributions for it to be financed. The PTA have generously agreed to subsidise the cost of this trip, making it more affordable for all children.
