When you do complete a reading session, don't forget to record it in their Reading Diary – this way, I can continue to update your child's reading card each week. We will continue to award your child with 1 Reading Point if they read at least 5 times at home in the same week.

Just a couple of reminders:

- Please ensure that your child brings their **reading diary** and **reading books** into school with them every day. Your child will have their reading books changed each week, but we cannot change them if books are not returned.
- As the weather continues to get warmer, please ensure that your child brings a **hat** and a **water bottle** into school with them each day.

- As we continue to have Outdoor Learning lessons each week, please ensure that your child has a pair of **wellies** in school. The children will be going out in all weathers and will need to be appropriately dressed.
