### Year 6 SATS information meeting 2025

We would like to start by thanking you for your continued support throughout the start of the children's final year at St Joseph's. We are looking forward to the rest of the year ahead of fantastic learning and helping the children to develop and progress further.

In May every year, children in Year 6 (end of Key Stage 2) take part in statutory assessments called Standard Assessment Tests (SATs). The children have been working incredibly hard this year and will be in a great position to fulfil their full potential in May. We have been helping the children to prepare and will continue to so that the SATs experience is a positive experience for them.

The timetable for SATs week (starting **12**<sup>th</sup> **May 2025**), which is dictated by the Government, it will be: Monday 12 May English grammar, punctuation and spelling: • Paper 1: questions • Paper 2: spelling Tuesday 13 May English reading

Wednesday 14 May Mathematics: • Paper 1: arithmetic • Paper 2: reasoning

Thursday 15 May Mathematics • Paper 3: reasoning

## **English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS)/SPaG)**

Children taking Key Stage 2 SATs will sit two separate papers in grammar, spelling and punctuation:

- Paper 1 is a 20-word spelling test taking approximately 15 minutes.
- Paper 2 is a grammar, punctuation and vocabulary test, which will involve some multiple-choice answers and some written answers. This is a 45 minute test.

#### Reading

The reading test for Year 6 pupils will involve one paper, consisting of a reading booklet with a selection of texts and a separate answer booklet, with comprehension questions related to the reading booklet. This is an hour test.

#### **Maths**

The Key Stage 2 maths test will comprise of three papers:

- Paper 1 is an arithmetic test, consisting of a list of calculations to complete. (30 minute test)
- Paper 2 is problem solving and reasoning. (40 minute test)
- Paper 3 is problem solving and reasoning. (40 minute test)

We will be holding a short information session on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March at 3.25pm to provide key information to parents about Key Stage 2 SATs. If you are unable to make this meeting, please let us know, so we can pass on any information explained at the meeting. We will also email out the presentation to all parents/carers for your reference. I will also have a selection of SATS papers available for you to look at in











the Year 6 classroom too. Miss Drury has kindly offered to look after the Year 6 children and siblings during the meeting.

Last year, we offered a bundle of SATs revision books which were great for the children – see the image on below. This bundle can be purchase at a reduced cost by schools. We would highly encourage you to purchase these for your children to work through during the holidays/the weeks leading up to SATS week. The cost will be £7.35 for all 3 books – this can be paid through Parentpay. So that we can get these books ordered for the Easter holidays, we need to receive payment money by Monday 17<sup>th</sup> March. This payment item will be assigned to all the class but if you do not want them please ignore it.
