Our new history unit, Diverse Dursley, focuses on our local history. For this trip to take place, we are asking that you pay a contribution of £10 towards the cost of this experience. There will also be a surprise treat in the afternoon, which your trip contribution will be going towards.

The children will spend the day at Woodchester Mansion, where we will take part in a guided tour. In the afternoon, we will focus our attention on how the Gothic era was created through art and design. Through the medium of clay, we will create our very own gargoyles, whilst developing our sculpting skills.

From a historical point of view, we will learn about how unique this listed Victorian Gothic house is, whilst considering the architectural work of Viollet-le-Duc and local architect Benjamin Bucknall. We will also learn about how the mansion is home to the breeding colonies of the greater and lesser Horseshoe bats.
