



Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back and welcome to St Catherine's class! We are named after St Catherine of Siena; a letter writer and Doctor of the Church. I am really excited to get to know your child and teach them this academic year. As you know, Year 5 is the penultimate year at St Joseph's and we start the process of getting your child Secondary ready. It is also the academic year where children turn 10, the age of Criminal Responsibility in the UK. This means Year 5 is about promoting **confidence, resilience**, independence and helping the children to understand their rights and responsibilities for the future. We have a lot of exciting new opportunities to facilitate this and much for the children to experience and enjoy!

Our main focus for the first term is to promote independence of conflict resolution, using our PSHE program of "Learning for Peace". Through circle time, games and activities, the children will learn about how to be at peace with themselves, each other, our school and our wider community. It encourages the children to show **empathy**, even when conflict arises; and how to defuse conflicts before they escalate.

We are starting off the year learning about Earth, Space, maps and the continent of America. We will be investigating time zones; lines of latitude and longitude; how to read and create maps; and what our Solar system is like. We will weave in **Stewardship** for the children to consolidate their understanding for our wonderful world. This will all tie into our RE unit of Creation and Covenant where we look at the Old Testament and the early promises God made to his people.

An exciting date for you this term:

On 13th October, we have a STEM day at Wycliffe, Stonehouse. This is a real showstopper of a day and one that the children talk about all year. More details will be given nearer the time.

- Please continue to read with your child at least 5 times a week, and practice their spellings with them. Consistently reading these with your children really does help enable them to **be the best they can be**.
