Year 4 Geography Trip

On **Monday 19th May 2025**, Year 4 are going to Purton Hulks on a Geography class trip.

Purton Hulks, or Purton boat graveyard, is a historical and geographical site of interest, where boats from the Victorian and War eras were purposefully beached on the banks of the River Severn to reduce erosion. It is protected by the Friends of Purton who have very generously offered to give us a tour of the site, and help us understand the geographical significance of the site, which links in perfectly with our curriculum.

Key information:

When: Monday 19th May 2025

What time: Leave school on coach at 9:30am, arrive back at school 3:00pm

What does my child need: Packed lunch, sensible walking shoes, weather dependant clothe (waterproofs if wet, hat and sun cream if hot), wet wipes as there are no handwashing facilities, PE kit to be worn.
