Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back! I hope you had a lovely and relaxing February half term break.

As we continue through the Spring term, we will be beginning new topics of learning. Our overarching topic will be 'The Minpins', which aligns with our current story book and English topic, in which we are learning to retell Our Trip into the Forbidden Forest.

Please do keep reading with your child as much as you can (and record your reading sessions!). We will continue to award your child with 1 Reading Point if they read at least 5 times at home in the same week.













As ever, it is hugely important that we try to secure reading sessions with the children as much as possible throughout the school day. If you would be interested in volunteering as a parent reader this term, please do contact Mrs Howells directly.

Just a couple of reminders:

- Please ensure that your child brings their reading diary and reading books into school with them every day. Your child will have their reading books changed each week, but we cannot change them if books are not returned.
- If your child took their wellies home for half term, please ensure they bring them back to school to ensure they are suitably dressed for Outdoor Learning.
- We would also be grateful if you ensure that your child brings the following each day:
 - A coat and scarf/gloves it may be starting to warm up a little bit, but it is still chilly outside!
 A water bottle.
