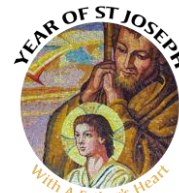

Beach Day!

This term, both Year 1 and Year 5 are covering a mixture of geography and history based on coastal towns. With this in mind, we have organised a trip to **Burnham-On-Sea** on Monday 3rd July. We are very excited about this opportunity and have planned to make it a really good day out. The Year 5's will be buddying up with the Year 1's to complete various activities in the location. We will also have time to play games and have sandcastle competitions!

Burnham-On-Sea is Mrs Hathaway's hometown, so she knows it extremely well. With the weather in mind, we will be stationed near the toilets and will have shelter from the sun - courtesy of Mrs Hathaway's Dad.

When booking coaches we could not believe the costs being quoted, (one being over £1,000) due to this, we have reduced the transport to 1 coach. However, we will need a couple of parents to help us transport some of the children. The PTA are kindly supporting the cost of the transport so in order for this exciting trip to go ahead we ask for a voluntary contribution of £10 per child.

Timings	Itinerary

9:45-10:45	Explore the estuary (links to Year 5 curriculum and parts of Year 1)
10:45-11:30	Break and snack back at camp
11:30-12:30	Walk towards the arcade and lighthouse on stilts (links to Year 1 and parts of Year 5 curriculum)
12:30-1:15	Lunch
1:15-2:15	Games and competitions
2:15-2:45	Tidy up, toilet and get back on coach.
4:00pm	Arrive back at school to be picked up by parents

Children will be required to bring:

- Rucksack
- Packed lunch
- Sun hat
- Be wearing sun cream (bring some for a top up)
- Water bottle (we will be able to refill them)

A message will go out nearer the time reminding you of what will be needed, alongside a close eye on the weather in case we need to adapt what the children will need to bring. Fingers crossed we continue to have this lovely weather.
