Just a few reminders:

Show and Tell

'Show and Tell' will continue to be on Tuesday afternoons. Please ensure that your child only brings **one item** to school that is **small enough to fit in our show and tell basket**. Show and tell items have included photographs, writing, cuddly toys, toy cars, etc. **Please note**, **there will be no show and tell throughout the month of July**.

• <u>Wheelie Wednesday</u>

Again, this will continue to be on Wednesday afternoons – the children love their sessions. Please ensure your child brings in a helmet on their wheelie Wednesday session. Please note, there will be no Wheelie Wednesday throughout the month of July.

• <u>Mystery Reader</u>

Mystery Reader will continue to be on Thursday afternoons. Thank you so much to the family members who have taken part in this, the children adore Mystery Reader! Please speak to me at the end of the school day if you would like to sign yourself up for a session - we still have some left! Please note, there will be no Mystery Reader throughout the month of July.

• <u>Water bottles/sun hats/sun cream</u> - We are hoping that the weather will be a lot warmer during Summer 2! Please ensure water bottles, sun hats and sun cream are in school every day and are named. It is so important to bring these in every day as the children are going to be outside a lot this term.

• <u>Homework</u>

Homework will continue to be sent home each Friday in your child's pink homework book. Completed work needs to be handed in on **Wednesday** and should be completed in **pencil**.

• <u>Extra PE</u>

I am so impressed with how well the children have developed their skills of dressing and undressing! Because of this, the children will **no longer** need to bring their PE kit in on Monday.
