Parents/ carers <u>MUST</u> book all sessions in advance. We will not be able to accept children arriving at OOSC without prior booking. This is due to staffing and room ratios being reached. The Out of School Club must comply with government guidance and must not breach these.

## Late Collection Fees

We are noticing that parents are regularly collecting late from OOSC and would like to remind you that we close at 6pm. If your child is booked in for an early session and you go over by 1 minute you will then be charged a full night fee. If you collect after 6pm, as per our terms and conditions which can be found on the school website under the OOSC tab, you will be charged £10 per child. Please note that staff are only paid until 6pm therefore if they have to claim over hours, this will cost the club additional money.

## School Staff Car Park

We would like to politely remind you that the car park at school is for staff only. When dropping your child/ren off/collecting them please do not use the school site. The reasons being for the safety of the children entering and leaving the setting and the insurance of staff vehicles.

## Holiday Club Dates
