

## Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are changing.

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force from 19th August 2024.



## **Poor Attendance**

Irregular Attendance:
Penalty notices will be
considered when there has
been 5 days of unauthorised
absence in any 10 week
period.



Fines will now be issued to EACH parent, for EACH child that was absent.

For example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave, would result in each parent recieving 3 seperate fines.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences within 3 years.

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates court. Fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child.

Cases found guilty in Magistrates Court can show on a parent's DBS certificate due to failure to safeguard a child's education.



## **Term Time Holidays**

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for Term Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

The first time a Penalty
Notice is issued for Term
Time Leave or Irregular
Attendance the amount will
be: £160 per parent per child
paid within 28 days.
Reduced to £80 per parent
per child if paid within 21
days.

Second Offence within 3 years.

The second time a penalty notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be: £160 per parent, per child,
