

- Please ensure water bottles are in school every day and are clearly named.






## **Lunchtime**

## The first few weeks

The children will each receive a reading folder which will have the following:

- Flashcards with key words
- Reading book (no words to begin with)
- Information on Phonics there will be a phonics evening in Autumn 1 to explain how we teach early reading and writing.
