

We are looking to appoint a part-time Learning Support Worker (26 hours per week) to work at St Joseph's Catholic Primary School. The role will be to work alongside our team to primarily support the learning needs of one of our fabulous children with an Education, Health & Care Plan, including lunch time support. Whilst these are the current hours, there may be an opportunity for this to increase to full time hours in the future.

Initially this role will be for an EYFS class, but the successful applicant should be prepared to work in any class across the school.
